Water on Earth moves in a never-ending circle called the water cycle. First, the sun heats up water in rivers, lakes, and oceans—this is evaporation. The water vapour rises into the air and cools down to form clouds—this is condensation. When the clouds become heavy, water falls back to Earth as rain, snow, or hail—this is precipitation. The fallen water collects in rivers and lakes, ready to begin the cycle again.
